EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBER x9999

How to report a campus emergency:

- **Emergency**, call **914-674-9999** or **911** if time is of the essence.
- **Non-Emergency**, call **914-674-7225** for general security assistance.

When you call x9999 or 911, don't panic, listen to the dispatcher, and do not hang up until instructed to. Be prepared to answer the following questions:

- Location of the emergency, including street address
- Phone number you are calling from
- Nature of the emergency
- Details about the emergency



MERCY ALERT

Sign up for automated alerts in the event of an emergency.

- Go to: **https://mercy.regroup.com**
- Log in using your current Mercy Connect **user name & password**
- Update how you would like to be alerted with email, text and phone/fax numbers.
- Click "**Save**" and exit the application
- Email Safety & Security at **security@mercy.edu** if you encounter any issues with the registration.

- Install the app to your device.
