

Mercy College has a variety of endowed scholarships to assist undergraduate students in meeting financial hurdles that would normally prevent a student from graduating.

**General Eligibility Requirements:**

- Must be an undergraduate student enrolled in 6 or more credits
- Student must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit all requested documentation
- Student must have completed two full semesters at Mercy College unless otherwise specified on the Scholarship description
- Must be in good academic standing
  - Continuing and transfer students: cumulative GPA of at least a 3.0 and above
  - Freshmen students: high school GPA of at least an 85 and above

**Scholarship Application Deadlines:**

**Fall 2018:** July 1, 2018

**Spring 2019:** October 1, 2018

Incomplete applications will NOT be reviewed or considered. All applications received after the above deadline will be placed on hold until applications received by the required deadline are reviewed.

**As part of the application process you are required to submit the following items:**
