

Accepted International Student Checklist

Once You Have Received Your Acceptance Letter, Complete the Following Items: Pay your Mercy enrollment deposit fee HERE. Complete the SEVIS I-20 Application Form - do not forget to submit the Affidavit of Support Form WITH your I-20 application. If you are a transfer student, you will need to submit the following items in addition to the documents above: 1. Copies of ALL previous I-20s 2. Copy of I-94 Arrival/Departure Record 3. Copy of picture page of visa 4. F-1 Transfer Form and get SEVIS record transferred 5. Copies of any previous EAD, SS card or miscellaneous Once you obtain your I-20 from International Students Services complete Form I-901 here and pay the mandatory I-901 SEVIS fee of \$350 (pay by check - click here for more information). Complete the Online Nonimmigrant Visa Application (DS 160)* electronically at https://ceac.state.gov/genniv/. Schedule a visa interview appointment with the **U.S. Embassy** or Consulate in the country you live in. Pay the visa application processing fee **BEFORE** your interview. Do not book your flight to New York before your visa is approved.

You can enter the U.S. no earlier than 30 days before your

program start date.



To Enter the U.S. You Will Need:

- A valid passport and F-1 visa.
- Printed and signed copy of SEVIS Form I-20.
- Documentation proving your intent to return to your country after completion of your academic degree.



After Arrival:

- Complete Post Arrival Form.
