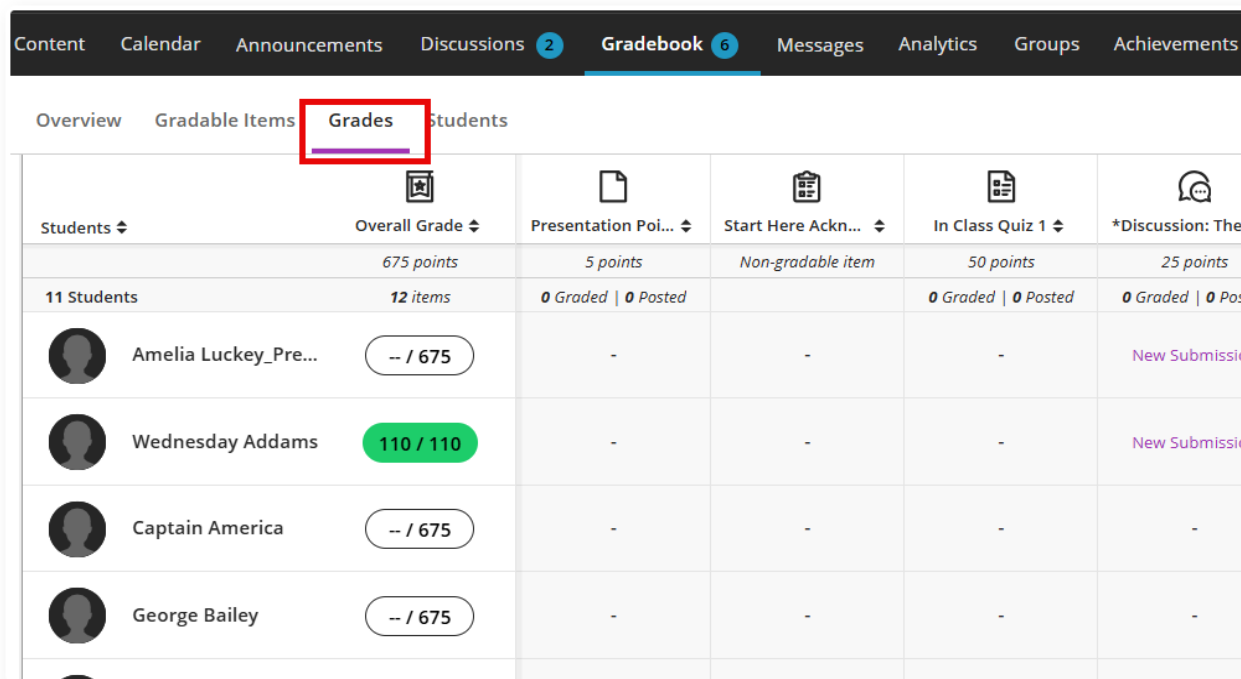
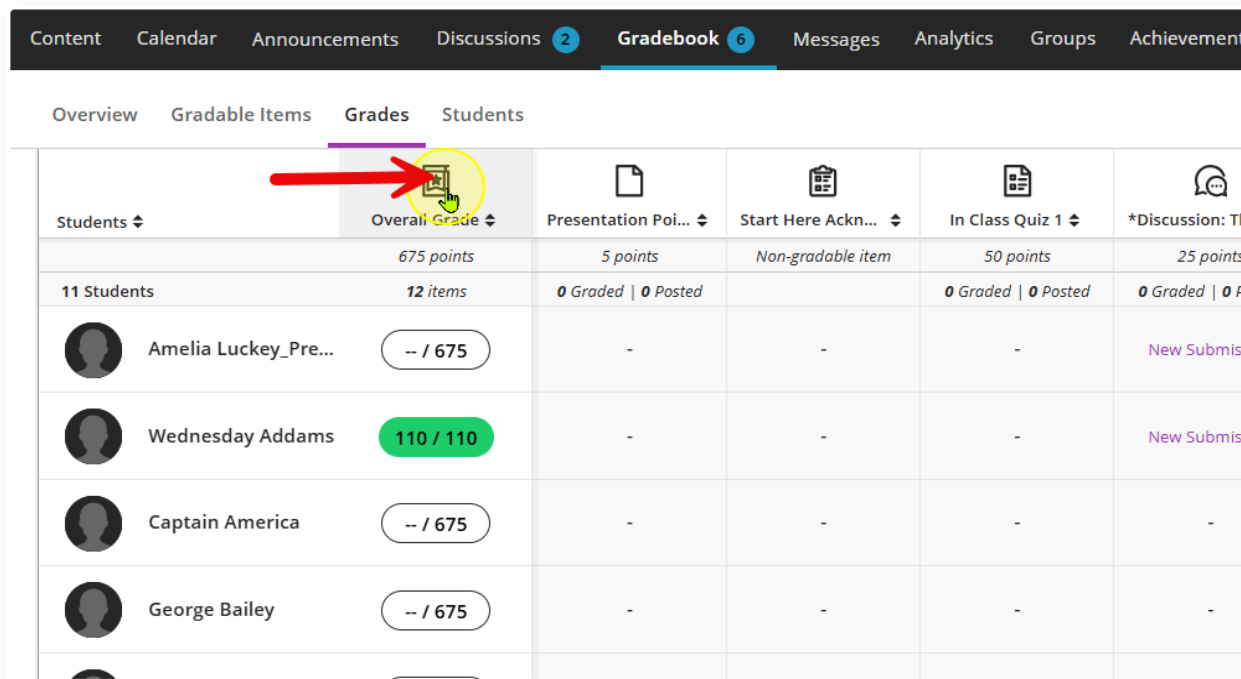


Viewing a Points Total in Blackboard Ultra
