Ethical Considerations

- Users should consider the ethical implications of queries and interactions.
- Engagement in public discussions and seeking input from affected communities is encouraged.
- Ethical guidelines should be continuously reviewed and updated.



Intellectual Property

- Infringement upon existing copyrights, trademarks, or patents should be avoided.
- Proper licenses or permissions are required for copyrighted materials.
- Appropriate credit and attribution should be given when using external resources or open-source components.



Privacy and Data Protection

- Users should review Terms and Conditions and the platform's Privacy Policy before usage.
- Informed consent is necessary before entering personal information; if consent is not obtained, data should be de-identified.

Accountability

- AI system feedback and responses should be monitored for unintended consequences; corrective actions should be taken.
- Incidents should be documented, learned from, and measures implemented to prevent recurrence.



Bias and Fairness

- Users should be mindful of potential bias in responses from the platform.

- Multi-factor authentication should be enabled for platform access.
- Credentials should not be shared.
