With approval, up to seven credits of General Prerequisite coursework may be complete during the summer of the application year. Completion date for summer coursework should be clearly indicated on this form and submitted with application. Applications will not be accepted outside of the application period. However, supporting materials will accepted under certain circumstances.
- It is not required to take any of the Mercy Specific Courses (the ones in the grey box) prior to submitting your application, although taking a few may increase your chances of being accepted.
- Once you apply (between March 15th and June 15th), you will receive a decision before the start of the Fall semester of that year, for the Graduate OT Program beginning the Fall of the following year. Your remaining prerequisites must be taken in the year between receiving your decision and the start date of the Graduate OT Program.
