 - b. Proof of funding (recent bank statement, totaling at least \$8,150 USD for one semester <u>OR</u> \$16,300 USD for one academic year). All financial documents must be in English, or accompanied by official English translation.
 - c. Mercy College Affidavit of Support, if you have a sponsor (family member) who is supporting you financially with your living expenses
- 2. Non-matriculated student application can be completed online <u>HERE</u>.

Additionally, please gather the documents listed below, and email as PDF files to <u>studyabroad@mercy.edu</u>. Be sure to include your full name and home institution in your emails:

- Proof of English proficiency (Cambridge B2, 71 on TOEFL, 100 on Duolingo, or 6.0 on IELTS) or Proof of English proficiency letter from your home institution
- Most recent academic transcript from your home institution (officially translated into English)
- New York State required immunization Records (Proof of immunization, indicating 2 doses of MMR measles mumps, rubella vaccine and Meningitis vaccine). If you have not received the meningitis vaccine and you do not wish to obtain it, you can complete our online waiver form once you are issued a student ID number.
- □ Proof of COVID-19 vaccine
